Spot Landing Contest Rules

- Briefing at 1:00pm, Contest begins at 1:15pm (Saturday, 10/18)
- Contest will be judged using two criteria, Distance from circle and style/grace.
- Pilots must monitor the CTAF 122.8 at all times.
- Pilots will make two landings. Only the best landing will count.
- Pilots will be required to sign a liability release prior to event.
- Target touchdown point is a chalk circle.
- Touchdowns prior to the target touchdown point will be disqualified (No landing short)
- Distance is measured from circle to the final touchdown point of the main landing gear.
- All planes will be handicapped based on stall speed.
- The decisions of the Fly-In Police are final. No Whining.

Safety First! This contest is an educational event designed to improve pilots landing accuracy.
